

# Signature work completed

CONSTRUCTION has wrapped up on the Gold Coast's newest waterfront and golf-course fronting development, the \$60 million Signature Waterfront Apartments.

The project has notched up sales worth more than \$29 million off-the-plan.

Overlooking the Jack Nicklaus-designed Lakelands golf course at Merrimac, the development has attracted buyers from Australia, South Africa, China, Japan, New Zealand, Singapore, Vanuatu, Korea and Dubai.

It features 69 apartments across two

buildings – one with nine floors and the other with eight floors – resort facilities and a private 12-berth marina.

Signature is a joint venture between the Global Group and the South Korean-based DY Group.

Global Group head Barry Jakeman said the combination of golf course living with the relaxed waterfront and marina lifestyle had been the catalyst for the success of the project to date.

“It's this exclusive lifestyle which drives the demand,” he said.

Apartments in Signature are priced from \$665,000 to \$1.19 million.
